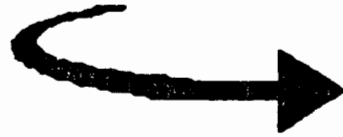




PAGENEERS WEST

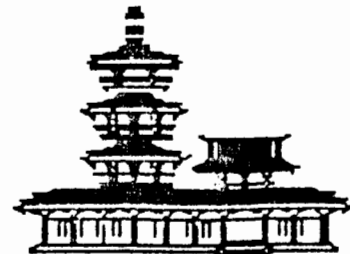

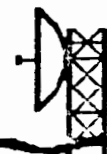

In the last few days I was in Bangkok, Bill kept asking me if I would have a cup of coffee for Old Page Guys that came through town. We wrote some and I always told him the coffee pot was waiting.

While putting in a circuit to Ventura I asked the guys on that end if they knew Bill Farmer. That's when I learned Bill had died. I called the Ventura paper and they read the story to me. That was in September, 1974. Bill died on the 13th. Half expecting Bill to be pulling something I went to his funeral.

Bill was a special man. He did a good job. A professional, he helped make us and the company look good. He got along with most, disliked few, and, in turn, was liked by all that I know.

Ventura man shot, killed in Vietnam

William O'Neal Farmer, 40, of 94 W. Warner St., Ventura, was killed Thursday in Saigon, South Vietnam. It is believed he was one of three American civilians shot accidentally by a South Vietnamese guard at a Page Communications Co. plant in Saigon.

Mr. Farmer's brother, Thomas, of Santa Barbara, said today the shooting occurred about 11 a.m. Thursday, on or near the Page property. He said the company's president had informed him the shooting was accidental.

William Farmer had been working in South Vietnam for Page Communications for seven years. He was an electronics engineer and was training South Vietnamese communications workers.

Born Dec. 12, 1932, in Dardanelle, Ark., Mr. Farmer was a 33-year resident of Ventura. He was a graduate of Ventura High School and worked locally for Pacific Telephone Co. for 10 years.

Survivors include his mother, Elizabeth Sue Harvey, of Ventura; father, Lance, of Dardanelle; stepfather, Otis F. Harvey, of Ventura; son, Michael, and daughter, Sherry, both of Ventura; and brothers, R. L. Farmer, of Ventura, MSGt. Carlton Farmer of Hill AFB, Utah, and Thomas L., of Santa Barbara.
